THE FOLLOWING RULES APPLY TO ALL CONTESTANTS.

- 1. The first fifteen (15) contestants (fee & application turned in) will be accepted. All contestants must reside in the Nederland Independent School District. After photos are taken there will be no refunds. No checks accepted!
- 2. **Poor sportsmanship** by a contestant, parent, or guest of a contestant at any point, including during reign, may affect future eligibility to compete in any pageant produced by the Nederland Heritage Festival.
- 3. During her reign, should the winner of the pageant fail to perform her duties, marry, become pregnant, be involved in illegal activities, drop out of school or incur any disciplinary action at school, not maintain the moral ethics of her position, then her title, crown & banner, will be revoked. The duties of Junior Miss will be fulfilled by the 1st Runner-up.
- 4. Each contestant will be responsible for 20 tickets to be given out at the parent meeting in January. No contestant will receive their packet or be allowed on stage until tickets and/or money is turned in. Tickets and/or money will be collected at pageant rehearsal.
- 5. Opening Number rehearsals attendance is mandatory.
- 6. Judges decisions are final and judge's sheets/scores will not be given out. If you would like a copy of the judge's comments for your daughter, you must bring a SELF-ADDRESSED STAMPED ENVELOPE TO DRESS REHEARSAL!! Sheet will be destroyed after one week.
- 7. Only one adult will be allowed backstage with each contestant and they must have a backstage pass. It is recommended that this person not be a parent or guardian.
- 8. Escorts must be either a relative or an adult friend (father, brother, cousin, etc). If this presents a problem, please contact your chairman.

JUNIOR MISS IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- 1. A general parent meeting will be held at the <u>Nederland Heritage Festival office</u> on January 2nd at 7:00 PM. This is a <u>mandatory</u> meeting for all parents/guardian and contestants.
- 2. A pageant rehearsal will be held at the PAC @ Nederland High School the week of pageant. This practice is mandatory for all contestants. It is recommended that contestants bring the shoes they will be wearing on stage. Escorts are expected to attend this practice.
- 3. This pageant will begin promptly at 7:30 p.m. Contestants must arrive at the PAC no later than 6:00 p.m. for the pageant. Junior Miss will compete in Interview, Casual wear & Formal wear. Interview will take place at 5:00 p.m. at the PAC!

PAGEANT OPENING NUMBER PRACTICE RULES

OPENING NUMBER PRACTICE IS MANDATORY.

The following rules have been established for all Nederland Heritage Festival Pageant Opening Number Practices. It is the responsibility of each contestant to participate in the opening number to the best of their ability. The success of the opening number depends on each contestant's participation and effort. Even though contestants are not judged during the opening number, it will be the first impression made on the judges the night of the pageant. These rules have been established in order for our practices to run smoothly and effectively for all contestants.

Demerits will be given for:

- 1. Un-excused absences = 1 demerit
 - Excused absences are:
 - 1. Death in family
 - 2. Extracurricular activities
 - 3. Illness
- 2. Tardiness to practice 3 tardies 1 demerit
- 3. Unruly or inappropriate behavior 1 demerit
- 4. Contestant must contact the Chairman or Co-Chairman to notify them of your activity/illness/excuse prior to opening number dance practice. Contestants will be notified if their absence is excused.
- 5. Contestants will be notified if demerits are given.

Notice of demerits for contestants will be given to the judges prior to the interview.
